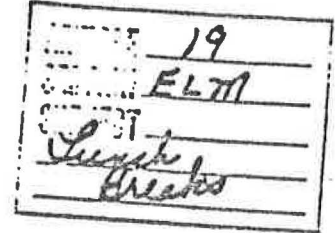

On December 19, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.


The question in this grievance is whether the grievant was properly compensated for the service day of August 4, 1982.
