

Dear Mr. Wilson:

On February 6, 1980, we met on the above-captioned case at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure set forth in the 1978 National Agreement.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that there is no interpretive dispute between the parties at the National Level as to the meaning and intent of Part 432.442 of the Employee and Labor Relations Manual concerning overlapping of hours from an old schedule to a new schedule. It is agreed that Part 432.442 of the Employee and Labor Relations Manual is to be applied in this case.

Accordingly, as further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to Step 3 for further processing by the parties at that level based upon the fact circumstances in volved.
