On several occasions, the most recent being August 19, 1986, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management violated the National Agreement by sending the grievant home after 2.70 hours work.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that the following constitutes full and final settlement of this case:

The grievant shall be compensated the average number of hours worked by other PTF clerks on the day in question.

The terms of this agreement are nonprecedential and apply only to this grievance.
