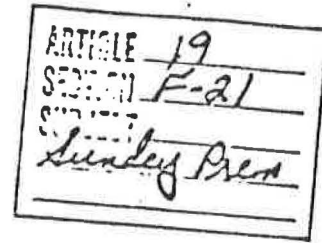

On May 10, 1984, we met to discuss the above-captioned case at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure set forth in the 1981 National Agreement.


The question raised in this grievance involved entitlement to Sunday premium pay.


After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in the particulars evidenced in this case. We agreed that the question raised requires application of Part 242.22 of Handbook E-21 to the fact circumstances involved.
