Dear Mr. Anderson:

On January 13, 1981, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The question in this grievance involves whether the grievant should receive night differential when receiving back pay.

In the instant case, the grievant received six (6) hours of back pay for missed opportunities of overtime. The back pay did not include night differential. If the six (6) hours in question were between 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., the grievant will receive night differential.

Accordingly, this grievance is considered settled.
