On March 11, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

This grievance involves the correct input for leave without pay that is used by union stewards.

During our discussion, we agreed that when a steward requests leave without pay for the purpose of performing official union business, the approved leave will be charged to LWOP-Union Officials (leave type code 28).

Accordingly, as agreed, this case is remanded to Step 3 for compliance with the above.
