On July 2, 1984, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.


The question raised in this grievance involved the local use of a BMC parcel sorter that had been modified to allow a single operator to do both facing and keying duties.

After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed to close this case based upon the following understanding. The local office has stopped using the modified parcel sorter; and the modified parcel sorter will not be used in other than the current test cities until the union is notified at the national level.
