On March 17, 1981, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.


The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The question in this grievance is whether or not management violates Article XIX of the National Agreement when sweeper-tyers on the LSMs in this local office are required to distribute mail into manual cases located behind the machines.

We find no violation in management's utilization of unproductive sweeper-tyer time to finalize machinable mail that has passed through the LSM.

Accordingly, as we find no violation of the National Agreement, this grievance is denied.
