
On June 20, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned case at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure set forth in the 1981 National Agreement.


The question raised in this grievance involved the assignment of non-MPLSM duties to MPLSM operators when they are not being utilized to operate the MPLSM.
