

On June 20, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned case at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure set forth in the 1981 National Agreement.

The question raised in this grievance involved the assignment of non-MPLSM duties to MPLSM operators when they are not being utilzied to operate the MPLSM.

After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in the particulars evidenced in this case. MPLSM operators may be assigned duties in accordance with Chapter 4, Section 452.le of the Handbook M-54.
