On February 7, 1984, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The question in this grievance is whether management properly required the grievant to key mail after returning from a break.

On a nonprecedent and noncitable basis and without prejudice to the position of either party, the parties at the national level agree to the following as final settlement of this grievance:

Management properly instructed the grievant to return to the MPLSM to key mail as fifteen minutes had lapsed since the grievant had previously performed the keying function.
