Dear Mr. Wilson:

On November 8, 1984, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The question in this grievance is whether management may assign (2) two sweeper-tyers to the MPLSM when (12) twelve consoles are in operation.

During our discussion, it was mutually agreed that the following would represent a full settement of this case:

Under the present M-54 provisions, a minimum, of (3) three sweeper-tyers will be used when the MPLSM is operating with (12) twelve consoles and is in full production.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to settle this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
