On September 13, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The question raised in this grievance involved whether a Level 5 Distribution Clerk is entitled to higher level pay when that employee is assigned sweeper-tyer duties on the LSM.
