On November 3, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.


The grievance concerns whether additional employees shall be assigned to the flat sorting machines specifically to cull flats before they are handled by the ledgeloader.

We mutually agreed that the issue in this grievance is not interpretive. Staffing requirements in addition to those specified for the FSM operation must be based upon local fact circumstances.
