On April 3, 1980, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

It is agreed that pulling bins and clearing jams on the sweep side of the LSM are bargaining unit duties. Local management is instructed not to perform bargaining unit work except where permitted under the terms of the National Agreement.

Accordingly, this grievance is remanded to Step 3 for determination of the appropriate compensation.
