n January 5, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned rievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure as set forth in Article XV, Section 2 of the National Agreement.

atters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The following represents a full and final settlement of the instant matter:

- The U. S. Postal Service acknowledges its obligations under Article I, Section 6.A of the National Agreement.
- The U. S. Postal Service acknowledges its obligations to comply with the Domestic Mail Manual, 160.346 and the Postal Operations Manual, 243.346 with respect ... to stamp shows, exhibitions, dedications, state fairs, conventions, parades or at other locations of activities of significant public or philatelic interest within the MSC and in concert with Item 1 of this decision.

It is mutually agreed by the parties that bargaining unit work was performed for a total of forty (40) hours work and that the two (2) full-time clerks who would have performed the duties enumerated in Item 2. of this decision will each receive twenty-(20) hours at the base hourly straight time rate.

Please sign and return the attached copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to resolve this grievance.
