On October 27, 1987, a prearbitration discussion was held between Nancy Forden and Jim Lingberg of the above-captioned case.


The issue in this case is whether Bulk Mail Acceptance Unit employees who handle mail can accept postage payments.


The parties agree that as provided in the Domestic Mail Manual (DMM), Section 145.66, employees who handle mail in Bulk Mail Acceptance Units will not accept postage payments.

The parties also agreed to remand this case to Step 3 for application of the above to the fact situation in San Diego.

Please sign and return a copy of this letter as acknowledgment of your agreement to remand this case, and withdrawing H4C-5K-C 7617 from the pending national arbitration listing.
