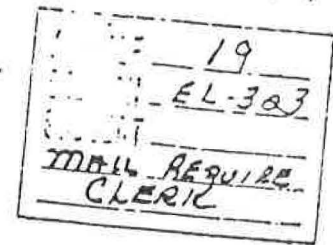

On several occasions, the most recent being September 24, 1985, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.


The issue in this grievance is whether management utilized proper selection procedures to fill a Level 5 Mailing Requirements Clerk position.


During our discussion, we mutually agreed to the following as full settlement of this case:
