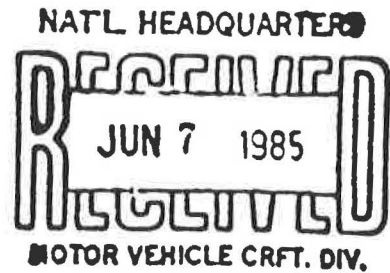

On May 21, 1985, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management's implementation of the Sick Leave Savers Program violated the National Agreement.

After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in the particulars evidenced in this case.

During our discussion of this matter, it was mutually agreed that the subject grievance is settled based on the following understanding:
