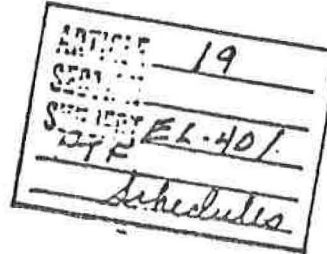


On March 11 and April 27, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.


This grievance involves whether management violates the National Agreement by requiring part-time flexible employees to clock-in five minutes after the hour.
