This decision supercedes my decision of August 6, 1981.

matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual praovisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The question in this grievance is whether or not management . violates Article XIX of the National Agreement with regard to eliminating the use of money order validation plates. The grievant expresses a concern for security.

Investigation has revealed that the requirements for using validation and limitations plates have been rescinded on a trial basis at this time.

We mutually agreed that if after the trial basis a decision is made to permanently eliminate the use of validation and limitation plates, the Union will be notified.
