Dear Hr. Anderson:

On December 11, 1981, we met to discuss the above-captioned ievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance ocedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The question in this grievance is whether or not management . at the Troy, Michigan post office violated Article XIX of the National Agreement by requiring the grievant to distribute mail using the MO-MIP method.

In our view, this grievance does not fairly present a nationally interpretive question.

A review of the grievance file disclosed that the grievant was sent for a fitness-for-duty examination because she stated that she could not physically perform MO-MIP distribution. The physician suggested a slight modification and management cooperated by implementing the suggestion for the grievant. Under these circumstances, it is our position that management took the appropriate action to resolve this grievance.

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to the parties at Step 3 who will ensure that the above provision is followed and the mailer's compliance is monitored by local officials.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowldgment of agreement to remand this case.
