Dear Mr. Anderson:

On August 6, 1981, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The question in this grievance is whether or not management violates Article XIX of the National Agreement by requiring an LSM trainee to train on keying Outgoing Primary and study a manual scheme at the same time. Specifically, the Union alleges a violation of Part 115.41 of the P-24 Handbook.

Local management is correct in its <u>technical</u> interpretation of 115.4 of the P-24 Handbook. This paragraph concerns the keying of schemes, not the keying of numbers and memory items.

Accordingly, as we find no violation of the National Agreement, this grievance is denied.
