June 16, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned jrievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

We mutually agreed that there was no interpretive dispute between the parties at the National level as to the meaning and intent of Article 19 of the National Agreement, as it relates to the duties of sweeper-tyers, specifically, assigning them the responsibility of collecting and weighing erroneous LSM mail.

It is our understanding that the duties referenced by this grievance may reasonably be considered as allied to the operation of the machine and may be performed by sweeper-tyers. Appropriate guidance in this regard is contained in Part 452.3 of the M-54 Handbook.
