Dear Mr. Wilson:

On June 4, 1980, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

During our discussion, we concluded that at issue in this grievance is whether Letter Sorting Machine operators should be given on-the-clock training when distribution changes occur.

After reviewing the information provided, it is our mutual understanding that Parts 550 & 552 Interim Publication 118 and Part 550 of the M-54 Handbook require retraining of keyboard operators when distribution changes occur. Such training may be accomplished in productive machine distribution or in a formal class setting. It is further agreed that a distribution change did occur in the instant case described in this grievance.
