On May 20, 1981, we met with your representative to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

We mutually agreed that, at the National level, there is no dispute between the parties relative to the staffing of the LSM Operation with two ledge-loaders when more that six consoles are in use. We also agreed that in resolution of this grievance, management at the Orlando, Florida Post Office will be informed to comply with the Gamser arbitration award on this subject.
