On March 29, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The issue in this grievance is whether the local implementation of the E2R (Expanded $2 i p$ Retrofit) modification was conducted properiy.

After Eurther review of the matter, we mutually agreed that there was no interpretive issue fairly presented as to the meaning and intent of Article 19 of the National Agreement.

The dispute in this case is suitable for regional determination by application of Assistant Postmaster General, Mail Processing Department's August 15, 1982, memorandum on EZR EDIT reports to the specific facts in this case.

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereoy remanded to step 3 for further development and consideration, if necessary, by the parties.
