On October 22, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure as set forth in Article 15, Section 2 of the National Agreement.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.


The issue in this case is whether "no hits" during a MPLSM EDIT should be counted as errors.


It is our mutual understanding that under normal operating conditions, a no hit during an EDIT is a "No Keycode Error" as defined in Section 521.i of the M-16 EDIT Handbook. The language in the cited section has been in effect since at least June 5, 1978.
