Dear Mr. Anderson:

7 Tanuary 3, 1984, we met to discuss the above-captioned at the fourth step of the contractual grievance ocedure.

The question in this grievance involved the assignment of a CFS clerk to the position of Accounting Technician on a temporary basis.

The union contends that when a temporary vacancy exists in a best qualified position; the senior qualified employee should be assigned to the vacancy.

The position of the Postal Service is that the position description for the Accounting Technician (SP2-443) provides opportunities and consideration for all crafts in an office regardless of seniority or PS Level when the position is being filled on a permanent basis. Therefore, the selection of a CFS clerk to fill the position of Accounting Technician on a temporary basis does not violate the National Agreement.

Accordingly, this grievance is denied.

The time limits were extended by mutual consent.
