Dear Mr. Adams:

On June 30, 1980, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that whenever Level 4 Mark-Up Clerks - Automated are required to distribute mail and this duty is not related to the duties and responsibilities listed in their position description, they shall be paid at the applicable higher level for that work in accordance with Article XXV of the National Agreement. The term "other job related tasks" used in the position description refers to allied work in support of the primary Mark-Up duties. Accordingly, in full settlement of this grievance those Level 4 Mark-Up Clerks - automated in the North Surburban Facility, who performed mail distribution identified as Level 5 work during the period in question shall be paid at that level. Please sign the attached copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of the agreed to settlement.
