

Dear Mr. Wevodau:

On August 16, 1985, and again on September 11, 1985, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether the Postal Service may settle an administrative EEO case in a manner that is contrary to the provisions of the National Agreement.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that the following constitutes full settlement of this case:

Detailing of employees to higher level bargaining-unit work shall be done in accordance with Article 25, Section 4, of the National Agreement.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to settle this case.
