On May 21, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.


The question raised in this grievance is whether Level 5 employees who perform sweeper/tyer duties are entitled to Level 6 pay solely on the basis of performing those duties.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed to resolve this grievance based on our understanding that the performance of sweeper/tyer duties, under the circumstances described in this grievance, is not justification for granting Level 6 pay.
