On December 17, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management properly denied a request for training to the position of relief VOMA.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. We further agreed that this issue is suitable for regional determination based upon the particular fact circumstances of the case.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing including arbitration if necessary.
