Dear Mr. Anderson:

On April 5, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

We mutually agreed to remand this grievance to Step 3 with the following stipulation:

1. If on Saturdays, or any other day, when the window technician is absent and the grievant is recognized as having primary responsibility for fulfilling the window technician's duties and responsibilities he shall be paid at the higher level. He is not required to serve in the position for at least a week to receive higher level pay.
2. If the above is applicable, retroactive compensation, if appropriate, shall be paid only during the 14 days prior to the filing of this grievance.
