Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On September 26, 1986, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether the withholding of retroactive social security and/or retirement was justified.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. This is a local dispute suitable for regional determination by application of Aricle 28 of the National Agreement to the fact circumstances.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing including arbitration if necessary.
