Dear Hr. Anderson:

On March 11, 1982, we set to discuss the above-captioned case at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The question raised in this grievance is whether or not management violated Article 33 by not selecting the grievant for an NFS Mechanic position.

A review of the information provided did not establish that a contractual violation occurred in this case. The grievant was evaluated for the position by a review board. The review board found that he did not meet the basic qualifications for the position and did not recommend him for selection.

Inassuch as he was not qualified for the position, his non-selection was proper.

Accordingly, the grievance is denied.
