Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On February 9, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance concerns the denial of a bid job to a senior employee who was not qualified on the appropriate examination for a Mark-Up Clerk position.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that the question raised can be resolved by applying the following:

Full-time Mail Processors will be listed on a merged seniority list with all other full-time PS-4 clerks and are eligible to bid on any posted PS-4 Clerk position. To be a successful bidder, however, they must meet the qualifications for the position, i.e., they must be currently qualified on the appropriate examination(s).

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to settle this case.
