On August 19, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The question raised in this grievance is whether the initial 204-B classroom training described in that grievance is counted towards the four-month period referenced in Article 37.3.A.7.


During our discussion, we agreed that any formalized supervisory training program is included in the four-month period.
