

On January 23, 1985, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in the particulars evidenced in this case. We agreed that the question raised can be answered by applying the provisions of EL 303, Section 142, to the fact circumstances involved.

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, if necessary.
