Dear Mr. Wilson:

On April 5, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The question in this grievance is whether or not management violated the 1981 National Agreement by not assigning the senior bidder to work the schedule of an assignment that has been deferred pending qualification.

It is not a requirement of Article 37, Section 3.F.3., that the senior bidder work the schedule of the deferred duty assignment.

Accordingly, as further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to Step 3 for further processing by the parties at that level.
