Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On July 27, 1989, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether the grievant is entitled to compensation for manual scheme study completed before her bid was revoked because of a prior lock-in period.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that the following constitutes full and final settlement of this case:

- 1 The grievant will be compensated for documented time spent to study the manual scheme for the bid position that was revoked because of her prior lock-in period.
- 2 Whether the grievant is entitled to restoration of annual leave or payment at the overtim' rate shall be determined at the local level by application of Postal Bulletin 21397, dated March 31, 1983, to the particular circumstances.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to settle this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
