Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On October 31, 1985, and again on February 6, 1986, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management is required to allow all bidders in contention for an MPLSM assignment the opportunity to demonstrate the required skills.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that the following constitutes full settlement of this case:

If the senior bidder defaults or withdraws from a duty assignment requiring machine qualifications, the deferment period ends. The senior bidder then qualified shall be permanently assigned in accordance with Article 37.3F(4) of the National Agreement.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
