In September 23, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned :ase at the fourth step of the contractual grievance rocedure set forth in the 1981 National Agreement.
question in this grievance involved whether management solated Article 37 of the National Agreement by posting an counting Clerk, Level 5 position with a typing requirement.
fer further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that - National interpretive issue is fairly presented in the articulars evidenced in this case. A determination as to hether or not typing is reasonably related to the efficient erformance of the responsibilities of the job at the allahassee post office must be based on a review of the fact ircumstances involved.
ccordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby emanded to the parties at step 3 for further processing if necessary.
