On September 23, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned case at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure set forth in the 1981 National Agreement.


Question in this grievance involved whether management violated Article 37 of the National Agreement by posting an Accounting Clerk, Level 5 position with a typing requirement.


After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no National interpretive issue is fairly presented in the particulars evidenced in this case. A determination as to whether or not typing is reasonably related to the efficient performance of the responsibilities of the job at the Tallahassee Post Office must be based on a review of the fact circumstances involved.

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to the parties at Step 3 for further processing if necessary.
