On October 20, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievnce at the fourth step of our contractual grievance. procedure.

The grievance concerns the grievant's contention that she has been performing the duties of a postage Due rechnician for orer two years. She requests that her present job be upgraded to level 6 and that she be paid back pay for the past two years.

We mutually agreed that no interoretive issue is involved in this case.

The Postage Due Technician, Level 6; position is authorized where the scope of daily postage due activity. requires that the employee spend at least 75 of the tinie on the oasic functions, and involves a minimur of 10 trust fund accounts with yearly revenue. in excess of 1355 revenue units.
Whether or not a Fostage Due Technician position is justified in this local ofilce can only be determined by review of the fact circumstances as they exist at the local level. Accordingly, this grievance is remanded to Step 3 for appropriate bandiing.
