Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On several occasions, the most recent being January 11, 1989, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether or not management violated the National Agreement by denying the grievant job #1418789, Distribution and Window Clerk, Middle River due to her hearing impairment.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed to settle this case as follows:

- The grievant will be provided appropriate combinations of training, testing, and practical demonstration of ability to perform in a Distribution and Window Clerk position. In doing so, management will take suitable steps to ensure that reasonable accommodation is made in providing the training.
- 2) Should the grievant satisfactorily complete the training and, with or without reasonable accommodation, be able to satisfactorily perform the duties of the job, she shall be placed in the subject job.

The terms of this settlement are nonprecedential, noncitable, and apply only to this case.
