On June 28, 1988, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management followed proper procedure in conducting the Window Clerk Examination at the St. Cloud Post Office.

During our discussion, it was mutually agreed that the subject grievance is settled based on the following understanding:

The qualifying Window Clerk Examination for St. Cloud positions shall be administered by the PEDC manager/designee at the Orlando MSC.

This settlement is without prejudice to the position of either party and may not be cited in any future grievance, arbitration hearing, or for any other purpose.
