Dear Mr. Tunstall:
On October 31, 1985, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether the said on-the-job training instructor was properly trained and certified.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. This is a local dispute suitable for regional determination by application of Management Instruction EL-730-80-11, dated December 15, 1980 (currently being updated) to the fact circumstances.

The parties at this level agreed that the PEDC is responsible for training and certisication of OJT instructors by using Ccurse 2150 5-001. Job Instructor Iraining ccnsistent with grovisions of Standard Training Program for newly appointed Window Clerks, Course No. 41513-00.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing including arbitration, if. . necessary.
