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On October 10, 1979, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

Having reviewed the information contained in this case file, we find that per the Memorandum of Understanding, Dated March 3, 1975, management informed the employee in writing of a new schedule for five working days or longer. Accordingly, no out-of-schedule pay is authorized in this instance.

There being no violation of the National Agreement, this grievance is denied.
