On November 10, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned case at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure set forth in the National Agreement.

The question raised in this grievance involved whether the grievant received the correct number of hours of training for a Mailing Requirement Revenue Protection Clerk position.

After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in the particulars evidenced in this case. We agreed that instructions relative to training hours for the position must be applied to the fact circumstances.

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, if necessary.
